

Updates to Female Lines of Sales Horses Since Catalog:

Through 8/21/16 (Copy in red is new since last update)

Hip 8 – CAN'T GET ENOUGH added his 12th win and improved his record to 12-7-5 from 31 starts after the 5YO gelding by Harbor the Gold took his third consecutive win at Thistledown on August 1 as he went gate-to-wire to take the mile and 70 yard allowance by five lengths and push his earnings to \$123,614. He is one of four winners – all full siblings out of Silver City Lilly, which includes SW Carabelle Harbor (\$146,237), SW Catalina Harbor and Sp Silver City Sizzle.

Hip 13 – FACE VALUED became the third winner for his dam Sugar Sleet when the 3YO gelding by Harbor the Gold took a MC\$25,000 at Emerald Downs on July 3, giving him \$17,013 in earnings. His full brother is being offered.

Hip 14 – SPIN FORTY, a 4YO son of Hard Spin out of Blue Ribbon Farm SW Sweet Fourty, came home with a 9 1/4-length tally to win for the 4th time (all his wins have come at Santa Anita or Del Mar) at Del Mar on August 5. He has earned \$88,340. Sweet Fourty has a yearling filly by Run Away and Hide consigned to the August sale.

Hip 17 – Two-year-old MAPS AND LEGENDS, a son of City Zip, won his debut – a five-furlong maiden special weight over Gulfstream Park's turf course – on July 3. He is the third winner produced out of Sweetgeorgiabrown, who also is the dam of \$461,107 SW Gunfighter and a yearling filly by Discreetly Mine being offered at the August 23 venue.

Hip 18 – 2014 Washington plater of the year, stakes-placed TOUCH THE SUN has won 19 races as of his July 19 three-length tally at Assiniboia Downs, pushing his money totals to \$155,525. A half-brother to three other stakes horses, his dam Sweethrtofsigmachi has a Nationhood filly consigned to the August venue.

Hip 19 – Washington champion Infernal McGoon, the dam of state champion 2YO filly Talk to My Lawyer – who has a colt by Harbor the Gold in the upcoming sale

– had her 4th winner when 2YO LIVININTHLEFTLAN (also by Harbor the Gold) took a maiden \$15,000 claiming race at Emerald Downs on August 6.

Hip 25 – AGATE BEACH became his dam Trust Nothing's first winner when he took a MC\$5,000 race at Emerald Downs on June 24 and pushed his earnings to \$7,382. His half-sister by Smiling Tiger is selling.

Hip 28 – Multiple stakes-placed OFFICER'S CHARM won the Fillies and Mares Spring Sprint Stakes at Lethbridge on June 19. She is the 2nd SW out of Wednesday's Out, who had her 7th winner from 7 starters when her 2YO daughter SOMETHING BETTER, by Finality, took her debut in a maiden special weight race at Northlands Park on July 2. OFFICER'S CHARM next won the Distaff Series #1 Stakes at Grande Prairie on July 16 and has now earned \$56,900. From July 30 to August 1 three of Wednesday's Out's daughters ran with great success in Canadian stakes races. On July 30, OFFICER'S CHARM ran second in the Distaff Series Second Leg S. at Grande Prairie. The following day, OUR TRIPLE CHARM, a 3YO filly by Finality, became the third stakes horse for her dam when she finished second in the \$11,720 Grand Prairie Derby Stakes. She has earned \$18,339 in her four lifetime starts. On August 1, SOMETHING BETTER went gate-to-wire to take the \$38,355 British Columbia Cup Debutante S. at Hastings Racecourse. Unbeaten in two starts, the juvenile filly has earned \$28,367. On August 14, OFFICER'S CHARM added her seventh win and upped her earnings to \$58,636 after the multiple stakes winner won a six furlong allowance by 2 ¼ lengths at Grande Prairie, Something Better, Our Triple Charm and British Columbian champion 2YO filly Finality's Charmer have a full sister cataloged.

Hip 40 – ASK NOT became the 5th winner for his dam Anazeha (Chi) when the 2YO gelding by Abraaj took a 5 1/2 furlong MSW by 3 1/4 lengths on 8/21 at Emerald Downs in his second start (he ran second on 8/7) and pushed his earnings to \$12,975. His half-sister by Coast Guard is selling.

Hip 46 – TEMPTATIOUS, a 3YO filly by Harbor the Gold, became the 5th winner from 5 starters for Washington broodmare of the year Bahati after she won a MC\$8,000 race at Emerald Downs on July 10. The now \$14,610 earner is a full

sister to Washington champions Del Rio Harbor and Couldabenthewhisky, Sp Legion of Boom and a yearling colt cataloged for the sale.

Hip 48 –Basket Copy, the winning dam of this Coast Guard yearling filly, is one of five winners out of SW Run a Copy – whose 5YO SMART COPY scored his fifth win on August 3 at Albuquerque, upping his earnings to \$83,944. 3YO COPY BEGONE, another offspring of Run a Copy, won for the 5th time in 10 starts after she took a \$15,000 claiming race by 5 1/4 lengths at Emerald Downs on August 5 and won a \$25,000 claimer just nine days later, increasing the daughter of Demon Warlock's earnings to \$57,238.

Hip 49 – GEORGE W won a mixed allowance race at Grande Prairie on August 20. Though not included in his Equibase totals, the four-year-old gelding out of Brookie Girl has now won 3 races. His full sister by Harbor the Gold is to be sold.

Hip 50 – UPTOWNFREDDYBROWN scored his 5th win in a Grants Pass allowance on July 3 and became a SW when he added a 6th victory in the \$4,200 Oregon HBPA Au Revoir Handicap at the Southern Oregon track and next ran third in the Prineville HBPA Stakes. **Uptownfreddybrown** took his 7th victory at Ferndale on 8/21. The \$42,711 earner is one of 6 winners from 6 starters out of Brown, whose colt by Horse Greeley is cataloged.

Hip 51 – IT'S LITTLE RICHIE took his third win by 5 ¼ lengths at Emerald Downs on August 5. The 4YO son of Harbor the Gold is one of 2 winners from 3 starters from \$111,034 earner Butterfly Belle – a half-sister to Washington horse of the year and multiple SW Reba Is Tops (by He's Tops) -- who has a yearling filly by He's Tops consigned to the sale.

Hip 54 – Three-time SW SALTY LE MOUSEE, a 9YO gelding by Salt Lake out of stakes winner Chasseur Dame, placed 3rd in the \$6,900 Inaugural Handicap at Wyoming Downs on July 9. He is a half-brother to 5 other stakes horses – including Washington champion Marva Jean – and a yearling filly from the first crop of Grade 1 winner Smiling Tiger.

Hip 59 – Crème (Chi) became a 100% producer from 3 foals when her 2YO daughter CAMANO COMET, in only her 2nd start, went gate-to-wire to take a MC\$25,000 at Emerald Downs on July 3. On July 17, CAMANO COMET finished third in a field of 11 in the \$50,000 Angie C. Stakes and has now earned \$16,513. WICKEDIZASWICKEDUZ, a four-year-old daughter of Private Gold, increased her win totals to three and earnings to \$51,985 after she took a \$15,000 Emerald Downs claiming race by 1 ½ lengths on August 14. The winning duo has a half-sister by Abraaj selling.

Hip 60 – MY GRANDSON won his 6th race – and 5th out of 9 starts in 2016 – in a C\$6,250 race at Albuquerque on June 26 to push his earnings to \$42,137. He is one of 3 winners out of Creole Delights, who is also the dam a filly by Ministers Wild Cat which is being offered.

Hip 67 – EN AVANT, a 3YO son of Lucky Pulpit, pushed his money total to \$18,633 after his victory at Emerald Downs on July 29. A half-brother to Washington champion and SW Trackattacker and two-time winner Nancy Wake, their stakes-placed dam Eclatante has a filly by Cause to Believe consigned.

Hip 68 – 2015 Washington champion MACH ONE RULES finished 2nd by a head to unbeaten Barkley in the \$50,000 Seattle Slew Stakes run at Emerald Downs on July 3. Mach One Rules, who has a 4-3-0 record from 7 starts, has earned \$123,823. He is the first foal and one of 2 winners out of Felice the Cat, whose colt by Sixthirteen is being paraded in the auction ring.

Hip 69 – Three-time 2016 Emerald Downs stakes winner O B HARBOR ran third in the \$200,000 Longacres Mile H.-G3 on August 14. The four-year-old gelding has a record of 6-1-3 from 12 starts and has earned \$163,191. His dam, three-time stakes producer Flying Memo, has his full brother in the sale.

Hip 72 – GOLD WILL DO, a 3YO gelding by Private Gold, upped his earnings to \$12,748 after he took his second win at Emerald Downs on August 13. He is the first foal out of Free of Heart, who has a colt by Raise the Bluff consigned.

Hip 78 – GOTTA BE DIET C, the 1st foal to race out of Gossip Queen, took her 2nd win in a C\$4,000 on July 10 at Emerald Downs and next took a \$10,000 claiming race on July 23, upping her winnings to \$15,550. Her dam's 2nd foal, a filly by Atta Boy Roy, is being offered.

Hip 82 – IN PRIVATE upped her earnings to \$22,593 after the 4YO daughter of Private Gold took her 4th win by 3 1/2 lengths at Emerald Downs on August 8. **GUARDIAN ONE** became her dam's 5th winner from 5 foals when the 3YO daughter of Coast Guard took her first win, by 6 3/4 lengths, at Emerald Downs on 8/21. She has earned \$11,695. Their dam, In Suzanne's Honor, has a yearling colt from the first crop of Car Talk (Ire) representing her in the sale.

Hip 83 – LIVININTHLEFTLANE, a 2YO filly by Harbor the Gold, became her Washington champion dam Infernal McGoon's 4th winner after she took a maiden \$15,000 claiming race at Emerald Downs on August 6. Also the dam of state champion Talk to My Lawyer, Infernal McGoon has a filly from the first crop of Smiling Tiger in the sale.

Hip 84 – NO WAY JAY became his dam Jadelet's 3rd winner after he took a MC\$12,000 by 4 lengths at Northlands Park on June 24. Jadelet has a colt by Ministers Wild Cat in the sale.

Hip 85 – HEART'S BEAUTY, a 3YO filly by Tribal Rule and the first foal for her SP dam Jasmine's Melody, won a maiden claiming race at Emerald Downs on August 20. In 3 starts she has a 1-1-1 record and has earned \$8,355. Her half-sister by Ministers Wild Cat is cataloged.

Hips 87 & 88 – IT'S MY KNIGHT upped her earnings to \$28,557 after taking her 2nd victory, in a C\$25,000 at Emerald Downs on June 24. She is the 1st foal out of Washington champion Knight Raider, who has a colt by Dixie Chatter cataloged. Knight Weave's stakes-winning daughter KNIGHT CLUB added win number 11 on July 15 and made it an even dozen after winning on August 5 at the Auburn oval. She now has a 12-7-3 record in 32 starts and has earned \$81,251. Her half-brother by Coast Guard is being offered.

HIP 91 – SECOND SHOT added \$14,260 to his totals after he won an allowance/\$15,000 optional claimer by 2 lengths at Thistledown on July 6. The 3YO gelding by Raise the Bluff has earned \$45,424. His dam Laurelhurst Lauren has a colt by Cause to Believe in the August sale.

Hip 92 –ARROM BEAR finished second by a neck in an allowance/\$62,500 optional claiming race at Sacramento on July 16. The four-year-old son of Nationhood—Lite Nite, by Conquistador Cielo, became his dam’s fourth stakes horse, from 10 winners, when he ran second in the \$50,000 Jess Jackson Owners’ H. run at Santa Rosa on August 13, upping his earnings to \$98,437. His half-sister by Atta Boy Roy is consigned to the 2016 sale.

Hip 103 – COMING IN HOT, a 3YO gelded son of Marino Marini and the first foal out of Miss Sandra Sue, took his second victory in gate-to-wire fashion in a \$10,000 Emerald Downs claimer on July 29 and **he added win number three on 8/21, upping his win totals to \$24,993.** His half-sister by Atta Boy Roy is cataloged.

Hip 106 – EVENING LIGHT, by Harbor the Gold, one of 5 winners from 5 starters out of Ms Melange, placed 2nd in an allowance at Marquis Downs on July 8 and has earned \$10,614 total. **Ms Melange’s top earner is MY CHIEF, a son of Harbor the Gold who took his fifth win by 2 1/2 lengths in the August 20 feature at Emerald Downs. He upped his earnings to \$56,900.**Their half-sister by Marino Marini is selling.

Hip 107 – JET PAK BLACK, a three-year-old son of Tribal Rule out of Ms. Moscow Mattie missed winning a \$25,000 maiden claiming race at Santa Rosa by a nose on July 31. He has placed twice and earned \$8,428. His dam has yearling colt by Coast Guard in the WTBOA sale.

Hip 109 – 2016 Sp CITIZEN KITTY, by Proud Citizen, added her 3rd win after she had a gate-to-wire victory in a C\$25,000 race at Emerald Downs on June 24. Washington champion No Constraints is also the dam of 2-time stakes winner INVESTED PROSPECT, who added her 4th win in 5 starts in a six-furlong Emerald

Downs allowance on July 9 to up her earnings to \$73,950. CITTIZEN KITTY took win number four in a six-furlong allowance/\$25,000 optional claiming race which she won by 2 1/2 lengths at Emerald Downs on July 30. The four-year-old filly has accumulated \$78,803. The fillies have a half-brother by Haynesfield entered in the sale.

Hip 114 – COLOR ME GOLD, a 3YO filly by Harbor the Gold, became the sixth winner from six starters produced out of SW and multiple stakes producer Premo Copy when she won a maiden claiming race at Northlands Park on July 30. She has now earned \$9,266. Her half-brother by Ministers Wild Cat – who is a full brother to Washington champion, SW and \$219,164 earner Castinette Dancer – is consigned to the August sale.

Hip 202 – Broodmare Crafty Vanessa had a couple of winning additions to her catalog page in the last few weeks. On July 21, her 4YO daughter JANAALAREE added \$7,800 to her totals with her victory at Presque Isle Downs. The daughter of Congaree has earned \$38,451. On August 7, Crafty Vanessa's stakes-placed half-brother, UNCLE WILLARD, added his 7th win after the 5YO gelding by Skimming came home first in an allowance/\$30,000 optional claiming (N) race at Hastings Racecourse, upping his earnings to \$75,060. Crafty Vanessa sells bred to Nationhood on an early March cover date.

Hip 204 – SO LUCKY, a 2YO son of Coast Guard out of Little Cutie's stakes-winning full sister Miss Pixie, remains unbeaten after he won the \$50,000 WTBOA Lads Stakes at Emerald Downs by 5 1/4 lengths on August 7. He had previously won the July 17 \$50,000 Emerald Lads Stakes by 3 on July 17. He has taken his 3 starts by a nearly 13-length total and has earned \$60,310. Winner/producer Little Cutie sells bred to Grade 2 SW and 2016 freshman stallion Atta Boy Roy

Hip 206 – EVENING LIGHT, by Harbor the Gold, one of 5 winners from 5 starters out of Ms Melange, placed 2nd in an allowance at Marquis Downs on July 8 and has earned \$10,614 total. **Ms Melange's top earner is MY CHIEF, a son of Harbor the Gold who took his fifth win by 2 1/2 lengths in the August 20 feature at Emerald Downs. He upped his earnings to \$56,900.** Ms Melange, by Slewdledo, is

a full sister to 3-time Washington champion and Grade 3 winner Slewsbox, is being offered bred to Abraaj.
