- 1) The WTBOA reserves the right to withdraw any horse from the Summer Yearling and Mixed Sale that it does not consider to be of an adequate physical standard.
- 2) **SALES NOMINATIONS RECEIVED WITHOUT THE CORRECT FEE AND WHICH REMAIN UNPAID AT THE NOMINATION DEADLINE MAY BE SUBJECT TO WITHDRAWAL.**
- 3) The number of yearlings for this sale shall be determined by the quality of the entries and not mandated by available stable space controlled by the WTBOA.
- 4) Upon acceptance to the Summer Yearling and Mixed Sale, an entry fee of \$325 is due by June 1, 2020.
- 5) Commission for each summer session yearling is \$300, or 6 percent, whichever is greater.
- 6) For each yearling that is sold or RNA and a commission is paid, a \$75 fee will be deducted from the consignor's proceeds in support of the WTBOA Sales Incentive Program (SIP). If a yearling passes through the ring as not sold and a commission is paid (RNA), the consignor will have the option to pay the additional \$100 fee to make each horse eligible for the program. Consignor also has the option, for any yearling that the buyer declines to pay the additional \$100 to make the horse fully eligible for SIP, to pay the buyer's additional \$100 and make the horse fully eligible to SIP.
- 7) All horses entered for this sale must either have been issued a digital registration certificate from The Jockey Club or have DNA testing posted and a valid service certificate and application for registration on file at The Jockey Club, along with all paid application fees, or the horse's entry to this sale may be denied without a refund of any fees.
- 8) Any horse NOT in residence in the State of Washington by July 19, 2020 (30 or more days prior to the sale), WILL require a brand inspection from state of origin, if applicable.
- 9) **UPDATED EVA REQUIREMENTS:** All uncastrated male horses four years or older, stallion prospects or stallions entered in a WTBOA Sale must have an EVA test, which must be submitted to the WTBOA Sale office at least two weeks prior to the sale date in order for the horse(s) to be allowed on the sales grounds. Test results will be available in the sales office.

WTBOA SUMMER YEARLING NOMINATION “EARLY BIRD” DEADLINE: MARCH 27, 2020



Beginning with the 2015 WTBOA Sale, all yearlings and weanlings that go through the sales ring and are made fully eligible will earn a lucrative bonus if they break their maiden at Emerald Downs at **age two or three** in one of **two levels of racing**.

- **\$2,500 SIP Owners’ Incentive Bonus*** if a SIP-eligible horse wins its first race in a maiden special weight, allowance or stakes race.
- **\$1,000 SIP Owners’ Incentive Bonus*** if a SIP-eligible horse wins its first race in a maiden \$25,000 or more claiming race.

A two-part process funds the SIP and is required to make the horse fully eligible:

(1) Consignors – who must be current WTBOA members in order to consign a horse to the sale – will automatically contribute \$75 to make each yearling or weanling in their consignment provisionally eligible for the incentive program.

(2) Buyers will then be offered the opportunity to make their purchase fully eligible by paying an additional fee. All buyers who wish to participate in the Sales Incentive Program must be WTBOA members in good standing on or before Emerald Downs’ opening day of the applicable race year.

- For current WTBOA members, the final SIP eligibility fee is \$100 per horse.
- Non-WTBOA members will need to pay a \$230 fee (includes \$100 SIP fee and \$130 WTBOA membership fee, due at time of sale) for the first yearling or weanling, but only a \$100 SIP fee for each additional yearling or weanling. WTBOA membership benefits will begin immediately and extend through the following year (i.e., membership will be good through 2021 for the 2020 sale).

**Bonus amounts and nominations fees are subject to annual review by the WTBOA Sales Committee and Board of Directors.*
