## WTBOA Stallion Season Auction Awards Program!

- ❖ \$5,000 Tier 1 Stallion Season Auction Bonuses Those stallions achieving the top eight (8) highest-selling seasons will be automatically entered into the Tier 1 Drawing. The winning stallion drawn will receive a bonus in the amount of 50% of the final season bid amount up to a maximum of \$5,000.
- ❖ \$1,000 Tier 2 Stallion Season Auction Bonuses All other stallions whose seasons sell will be automatically entered into the Tier 2 Drawing. The winning stallion will earn a bonus in the amount of 50% of the final season-bid amount up to a maximum of \$1,000.
  - Both drawings will be held on the evening of the Washington Annual Awards Banquet, tentatively scheduled for Saturday, February 24, 2024.
  - All Tier 1 stallions, including the names of the farms where they stand, will be featured in the Awards Banquet program, in the Champions issue of *Washington Thoroughbred* magazine, and in all promotional information for the following year's Stallion Season Auction.
  - o Bonus amounts will be paid to the stallion owner.
  - o Final bid amounts will *not* be made public.

amounts will be available for all progeny of stallions whose seasons for the 2024 season *sell* during the online auction. The bonus(es) will be paid to the winning owner(s) of the eligible horse(s).

- ❖ The Stallion Season Auction will again be hosted online at **Thoroughlybred.com**.
- ❖ The dates for this year's online auction are **December 15-22**.
- ❖ We are thrilled to report that last year's auction results once again eclipsed all previous auctions!
- ❖ A complete list of donated stallion seasons, along with the specific information pertaining to your stallion(s), will be promoted online to a *nationwide audience*.
- ❖ All Stallion Season Auction information, as well as the stallion listings, will also be promoted on the WTBOA website at washingtonthoroughbred.com, as well as in our e-newsletter and on social media.
- ❖ Donations are not split with the season donor and/or stallion owner. Only 100% donated seasons accepted.
- ❖ Stallion owners/managers reserve the right to accept only Thoroughbred broodmares that are clean and sound for breeding. Under no circumstances shall a live foal be guaranteed. However, you do have the option of offering a return.
- ❖ The name(s) and address(es) of any successful bidder(s) on your 2024 stallion season(s) will be supplied to you after the auction. It is the responsibility of the stallion owner to supply a contract to the purchaser of the season after being notified of payment.
- ❖ Final bid amounts will *not* be announced or published.
- Any season that does not receive a bid by the initial online closing date will be offered in secondary auction(s) that will take place during the week to 10 days (up to one month) following the featured auction dates.
- ❖ Stallion owners have the option to buy their stallion season back at the minimum bid, if it does not sell, to make all of said stallion's foals eligible for the aforementioned three-year-old stakes bonuses.
